# Supporting Informed and Respectful Research

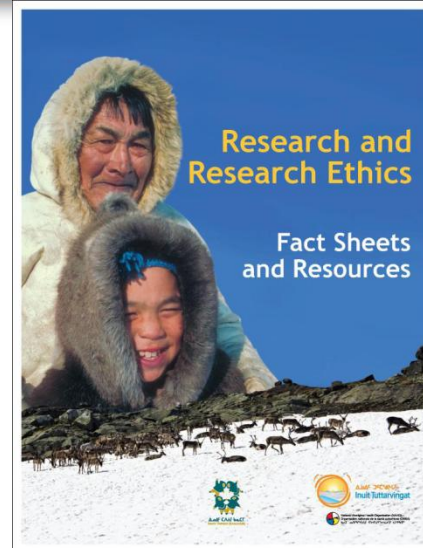
- Inuit Tuttarvingat supports informed and respectful research
